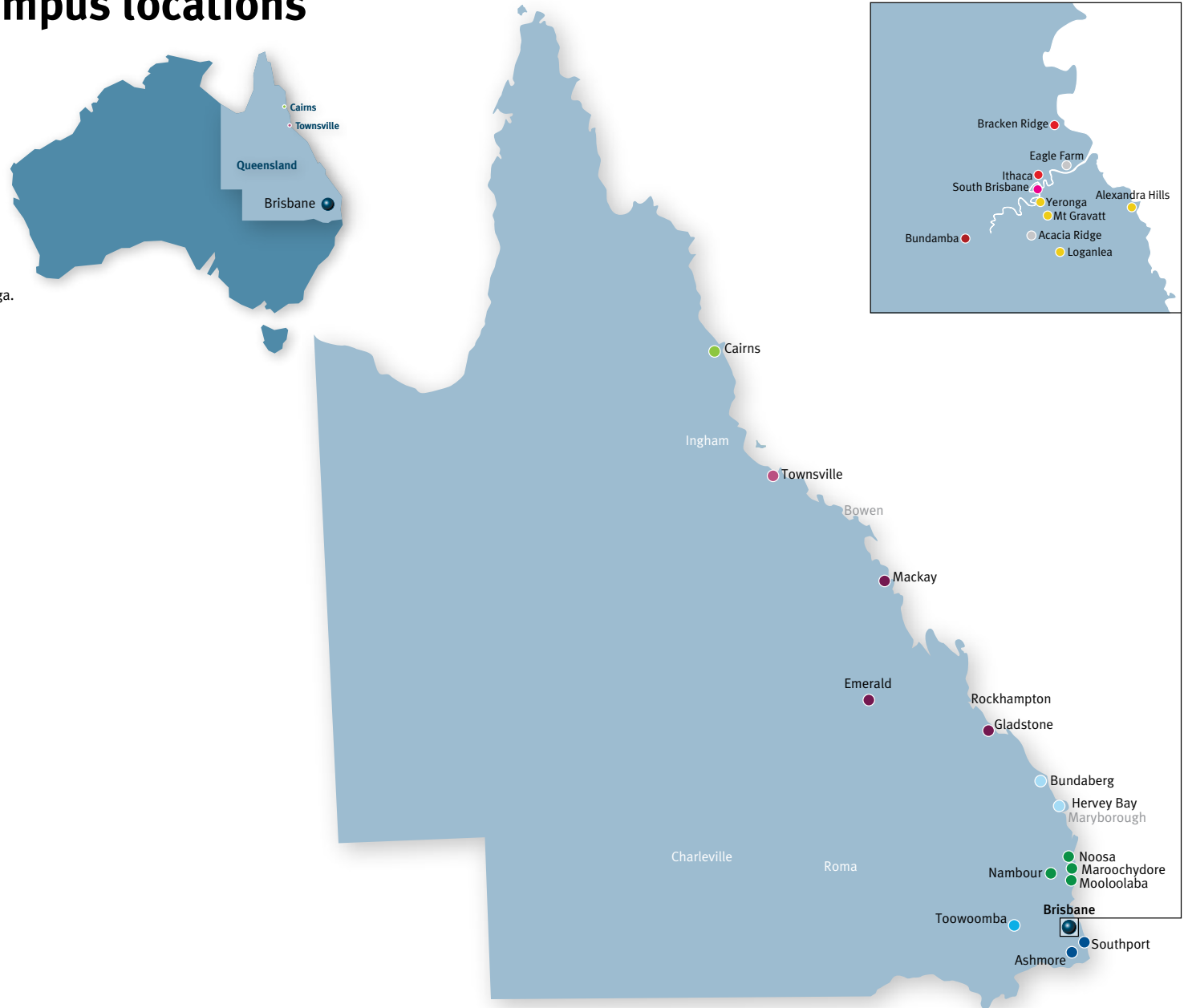

Tuition fees

International students are charged up-front fees. These fees will vary depending on the course and institute. Institutes will advise of all fees associated with your chosen course prior to your enrolment.

Health and medical insurance

Australia has a system of health care cover for international students called Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). International students studying in Australia must have adequate arrangements for health and medical insurance for the duration of their student visa.

Recognition of Prior Learning

- Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is a process that recognises a student's current and relevant skills and experience regardless of where and when the learning occurred.
- A student's prior knowledge and experience, if relevant, may reduce the completion time of a program of study.
- A student may apply for recognition of prior learning that is relevant to their course of study, and so gain some credit towards their course.
- Students can base their application for RPL on any combination of formal or informal training and education, work experience or general life experience.
- To apply for Recognition of Prior Learning at TAFE Queensland, students will need to complete an RPL form and provide supporting evidence when they enrol for a course.
- Recognition of Prior Learning at TAFE Queensland may also assist you to enter University with credit for part of a university course. See the 'Pathways' diagram on page 7.

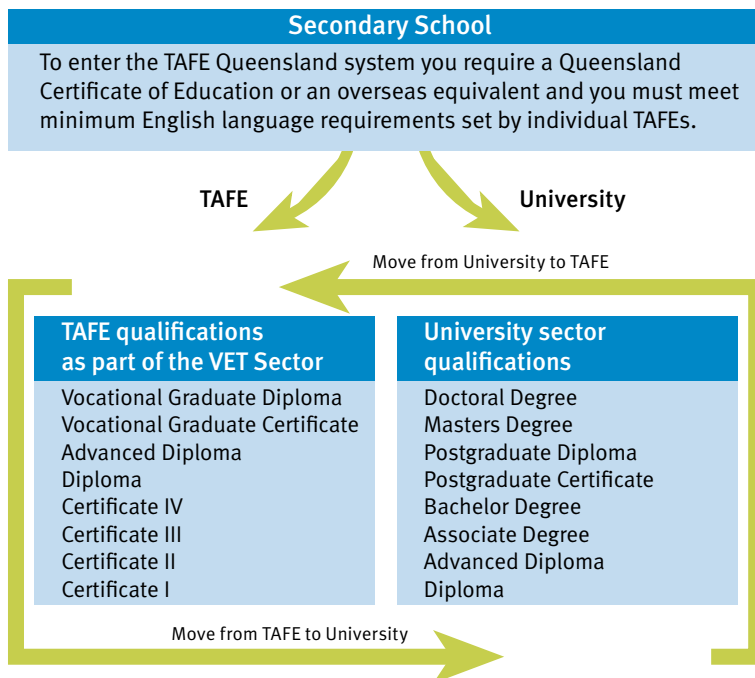

TAFE – University Pathways

Australian Qualifications Framework educational pathways from TAFE qualifications to university qualifications



➤ TAFE studies may give you credit to access university in three ways:

1. A full TAFE qualification may be equal to a full year or a part of a university qualification
2. Competencies or skills gained in a full TAFE qualification may give you credit for specific components of a university qualification
3. Parts of a TAFE qualification may give you credit for components of a university qualification

➤ University graduates may enrol in TAFE training to obtain practical experience required by employers, or to gain supplementary skills.

Entry requirements

Minimum age

Students wishing to study with TAFE Queensland must be a minimum of 16 years of age or older.

Visa requirements

You need a student visa to study in Australia for more than 12 weeks. Short stay visas apply for students studying in Australia for less than 12 weeks.

English language requirements

International students whose first language is not English require a minimum level of English language skills to study a TAFE Queensland program. English requirements, often determined by industry standards, may vary from institute to institute depending on the study program.

Check with your TAFE institute to determine whether you meet requirements. Find out more at www.tafe.qld.gov.au/students/international/enrol/

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is universally recognised as evidence of English language ability. TAFE Queensland may accept other English language ability tests which would be indicated on Institutes' individual websites. However depending on your country of origin, the Australian

Department of Immigration and Citizenship may accept only an IELTS result as proof of English language competency for the purpose of student visa application.

If you do not meet the criteria TAFE Queensland can help you gain the skills through their extensive English language training programs. Please contact individual institutes for more information.
